Google Earth Pro basics

To explore a specific location in Google Earth

Drag the yellow man on the map

Blue lines show where Street View is available

Street View provides high quality images of surrounding areas

Dropping the man anywhere outside a blue line shows only ground-level view

You can often populate this view with 3D buildings to help identify landmarks

Select this layer to view 3D options

For alternative angles and detail you can view photographs shared by members of the public

Selecting photos in the side panel adds a layer of geopositioned icons

Blue icons reveal normal photographs

Red icons reveal 360 photographs

For remote areas with fewer landmarks and photographs select the terrain layer

This provides a detailed view of the landscape including elevation
