Trump Says He Is Willing to Speak Under Oath to Mueller

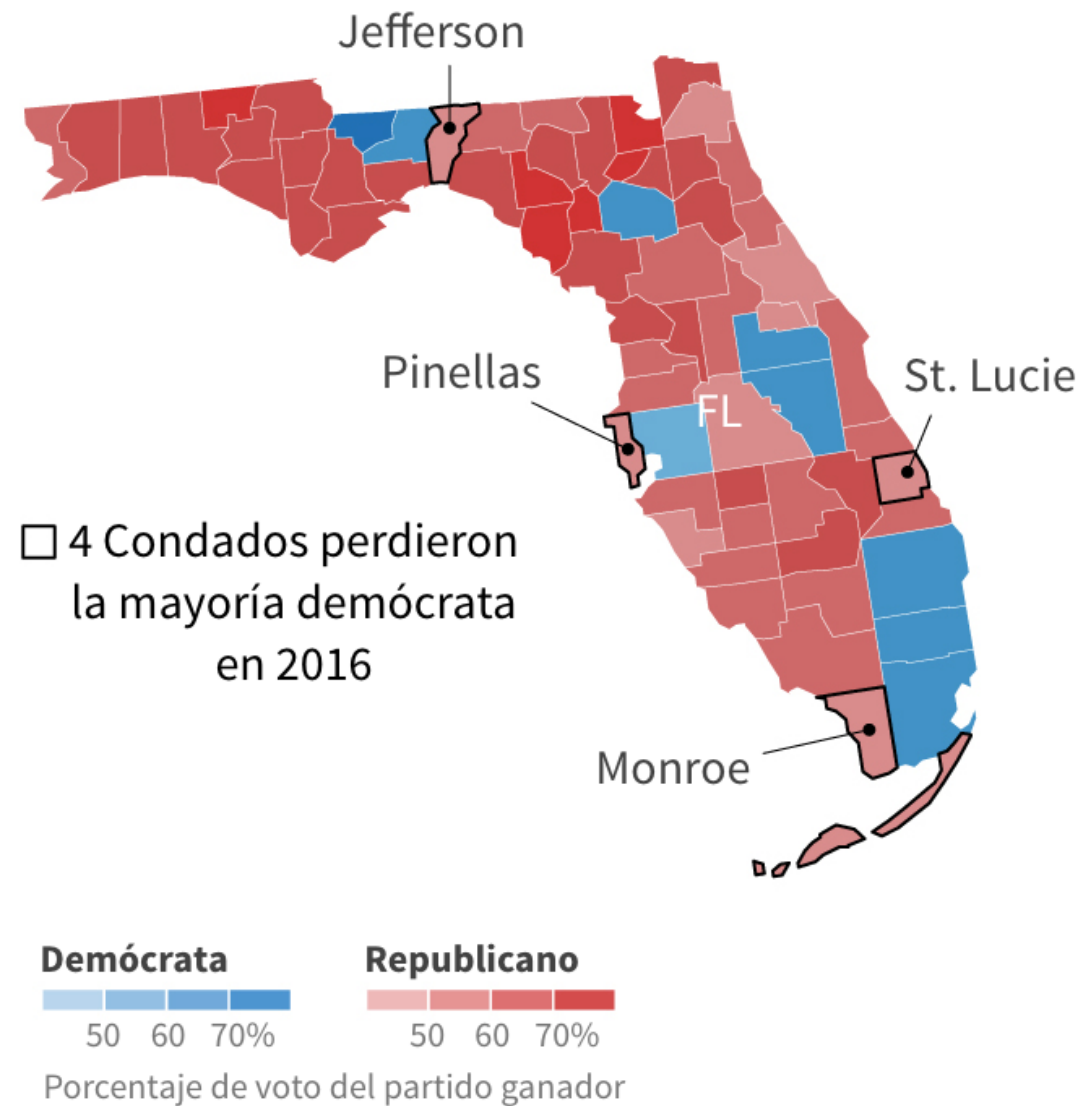

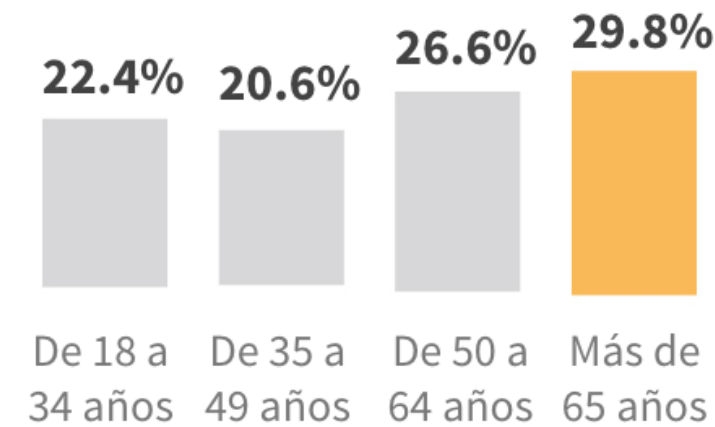

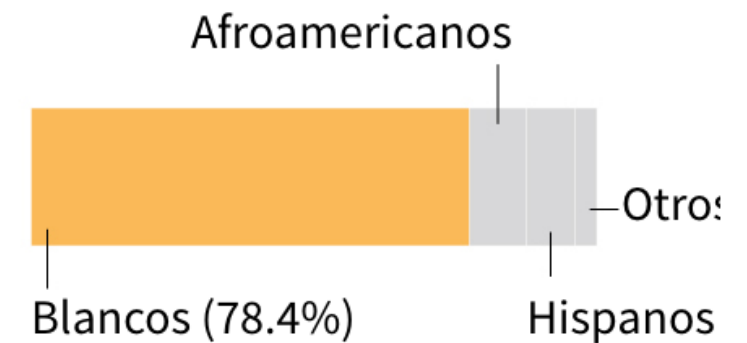


Composición de los votantes registrados en los 58 condados donde ganó el Partido Republicano

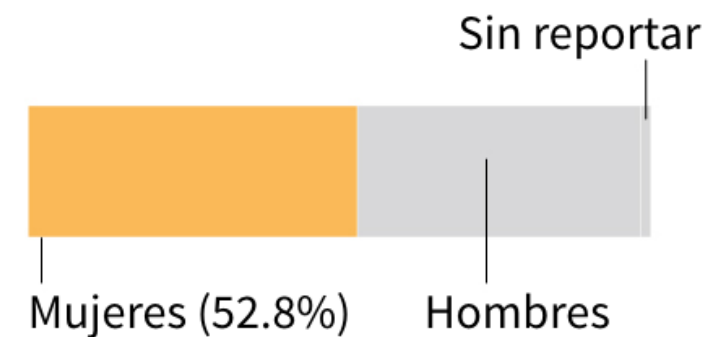
